Fellowship Positions Available

One and two-year Fellowship positions will be available at the University of Toronto Department of Radiation Oncology, located at either the Princess Margaret Hospital or the Odette Cancer Centre, starting in July 2011.

The **one-year Clinical Research Fellowship** positions are aimed at acquiring a high level clinical experience in clinical research and advanced planning and treatment techniques. Positions are available for all major tumor sites as well as in symptom management, prostate brachytherapy, and drug-radiation interaction. This Fellowship is generally divided approximately 50/50 between clinical experience and research, although an enriched clinical program may be considered.

A limited number of **two-year Research Fellowships** provide in-depth training in the principles and methods of scientific research in basic, translational, technology, clinical, or education research. Fellows will also enroll in a graduate degree program (Masters) at the University of Toronto. We have strong translational and technology programs particularly in Breast, Gynecology, Genitourinary, Head & Neck, and Lung sites, as well as experimental therapy approaches.

Details concerning the Program and potential faculty supervisors may be found on the Department of Radiation Oncology website at www.dro.facmed.utoronto.ca. Applicants must have completed their training in Radiation Oncology prior to commencement of the Fellowship. Preference will be given to candidates with training and experience with high technology radiotherapy and a track record in clinical or translational research. A personal interview is an asset, and these will be conducted in Toronto or at international scientific meetings.
