BACKGROUND: Perth is an attractive major city (population 1.6 million) with a warm climate and beautiful beaches and Western Australia is renowned for its remarkable natural environment.

The Radiation Oncology Department, Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital, is a progressive department, actively involved in research and development with a major participation in clinical trials.

Equipment includes six Varian linacs, with IMRT, IGRT, and gating capability, Toshiba wide bore CT, Elekta XiO/Focal TPS, Brainlab stereotactic planning system, Varian HDR, I-125 LDR equipment and an IntraBeam intra-operative 50 kV x-ray device. Specialised techniques include IMRT, IGRT, stereotactic radiotherapy, HDR and I-125 seed LDR brachytherapy, intra-operative breast treatment and photon TBI.

The Physics section is well equipped and currently consists of 10 clinical, 3 registrar, 0.5 preceptor and 1 research physicist positions.

POSITION: We are seeking two suitably qualified and experienced physicists to assist in the provision of physics services to Radiation Oncology and the ongoing implementation of new equipment and treatment techniques.
