We are seeking expressions of interest from radiotherapy researchers for the position of 'CERRO Co-Chair' to replace Marianne Koritzinsky who will be stepping down in January 2024.

The role of the CERRO Co-Chair is to work with the other Co-Chairs (currently Uulke van der Heide and Anthony Chalmers) and the ESTRO office (currently represented by Miika Palmu) to organise and oversee the efficient running of the annual ESTRO Conference on Experimental Radiation biology and Radiation Oncology. The Co-Chairs work together to nurture the collaborative, creative and inclusive atmosphere for which CERRO is renowned, and to maximise the scientific quality, international scope and multidisciplinary reach of the conference. The successful candidate has participated in CERRO in previous years and will be expected to attend the CERRO meeting every year, play an active role in welcoming delegates, encouraging participation and facilitating social and academic interactions

The current CERRO co-chairs will make a recommendation to the Scientific Council, who then will make the appointment in the meeting of February 21.
