

Join the ESTRO Mentoring Programme!

The ESTRO mentoring programme is continuing with its 3rd edition! With 20 mentees being mentored in the current edition we are happy to continue this initiative of young ESTRO and of the Education Council!

Therefore, the programme will be continued with a new edition at the next annual ESTRO congress, ESTRO 2024, taking place 3-7 May 2024, in Glasgow.

What's in it for the mentee?

- Discuss queries regarding personal and professional growth with those ahead of you;
- Reflect on your professional aims;
- Broaden your European network.

What is in it for the mentor?

- Gaining personal satisfaction by making a difference for young professionals;
- Improving their own coaching and listening skills and nurturing ability;
- Learning to better understand a new generation of (international) professionals;
- Contributing to ESTRO vision by shaping the new generation of radiation oncology professionals.

Organization of the program

In a Meet&Greet session at ESTRO 2024 in Glasgow, mentees will get to know a number of possible mentors. Mentee-mentor couples will then be formed based on preferences of the mentees and mentors. Between ESTRO 2024 and 2025, both mentor and mentee commit themselves for one year, with at least one meeting (physical, phone, online) every three months of approximately one hour.

Sponsorship and/or scientific collaboration are not the main goal of the programme.

Who can apply?

Early-stage career ESTRO members from all professions under the age of 40 or within ten years of finishing their training, with minimal two years of postgraduate work experience that are aware of recent developments in their field.

The programme has room for 20 mentees.

Mentees will be selected by the yESTRO committee based on CV, ESTRO activities participation and motivation. We strive for a balance in terms of geographical location, gender and profession (clinic, physics, biology and RTT)..
