POSTER HIGHLIGHT INFORMATION

Poster Highlight sessions are live sessions, including 4-minute recorded PowerPoint (maximum 4 slides excluding the title slide) presentation given by authors of accepted abstracts. <u>No separate</u> poster PDF is required.

Session will be scheduled as follow:

- 2-minute introduction by the chairs at the beginning of the session
- 4-minute pre-recorded PowerPoint (4 slides excluding the title slide) presentation
- 4-minute interactive live Q&A led by the chairs

During the presentation, moderators will collect the questions addressed by the participants via the Q&A function. These questions will be discussed live at the end of each poster presentation. <u>Poster highlight sessions will be broadcast live in the online congress platform.</u> The session will then be available on-demand shortly after the end of the session.

ONLINE UPLOADING PLATFORM

Authors are kindly asked to submit their presentation via the online uploading platform. <u>The deadline for</u> <u>uploading is Wednesday 11 August 2021 at 23:59 CEST.</u>

An email will be sent to authors with a link to connect to the platform and follow the steps:



After uploading a presentation, authors should receive a confirmation email. If they do not receive a confirmation email, they should check their junk folder and/or contact us as soon as possible via email (support@cyimhelp.zendesk.com).

PRESENTATION FORMATTING

To ensure an optimal delivery of the presentation:

• The presentation must be prepared in <u>a 4-slide (excluding the title slide) Microsoft PowerPoint</u> and saved as a **PPTX format**.

- The presentation will be displayed in landscape orientation 16/9 ratio.
- Respect author's rights and anonymity.
- A **PowerPoint template** to create content can be used: <u>DOWNLOAD PRESENTATION TEMPLATE</u> <u>IMPORTANT! The recording system will automatically cut after the allocated time of 4 minutes.</u> <u>The length of the presentation is indicated in the platform.</u>

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HOW TO RECORD YOUR PRESENTATION

We recommend for an optimal result:

- To use a headset with a microphone
- Have a good internet connection AND use the browser Chrome (DOWNLOAD CHROME)
- Record the presentation in a quiet room with no background noise
- Prepare the speech in advance if needed
- Make sure the presenter is seated comfortably, that the background is clear, and that their face is clearly visible.



Record the presentation using full screen view, not presenter view.
