



Call to join the yESTRO Committee

Dear Young ESTRO member,

We would like to draw your attention to a vacancy in the yESTRO Committee for a RTT.

yESTRO is the committee of ESTRO that represents the young radiation oncology community in Europe. We stand for that "young Radiation Oncology professionals feel at home in ESTRO, and are being prepared to lead ESTRO and the profession into the 2030's".

Our focus areas are:

- To connect young ESTRO members with each other and ESTRO and its members
- To foster professional and leadership development of new members
- To detect unmet needs and improve the Society as a whole.

One member will reach the end of her second term in 2024 and therefore, we are looking for one new RTT member.

- Work together with a highly motivated group of yESTRO Committee members

- Help organizing our activities, such as the young track at the annual congress, the Opinion Panel, the mentoring program, the yESTRO Committee newsletter, etc
- Typically spend 2 hours per week on average on yESTRO Committee activities

Who can apply?

For the current call, we are looking one RTTs, aged less than 35 years and/or within five years after finishing training / PhD*. Applicants that do not fulfill the age/years of experience requirement should motivate their application as a young ESTRO member (e.g. due to career breaks). We strive for a diverse committee in terms of gender, professional background and geographical allocation.

^{*} The criteria for a young member are younger than 40 years or within 10 years of finishing a PhD or training. Exceptions can be granted based on e.g career breaks. Since the term of a membership is 3 years and can be renewed once, the criteria for the vacancies of 35 years and 5 years from finishing training, more or less ensure that yESTRO Committee members can be considered 'young' during their terms.
